

Due to a recent decision by the Vermont Supreme Court declaring certain information on tax bills (and tax payments) to be confidential, tax bills that show the two individual installment amounts, state payment (if applicable) and net tax due will now only be provided to the property owner. Tax payment information will also be very limited to anyone other than the property owner. Tax bills are always mailed to the property owner of record as of April 1st. As always, it is the property owner's responsibility to provide a copy of the tax bill to their bank, mortgage or escrow company. If you want a copy of your tax bill or payment information to be released to another party (bank, mortgage, escrow, tax prepare, etc.) send a written authorization to Treasurer's Office, PO Box, 461, Corinth, VT 05039 making that request, be sure to sign, print your name and date. For your convenience you can use the form below to make the request.
