- 1) Call to order @ 7:12
- 2) Approval of June minutes: done
- 3) Agenda changes: none
- 4) Public comment: none
- 5) Treasurer/ financials update: as of 6/30/21, CCC has \$6319.38 in account and Town Forest account has \$2802.98. Those numbers do not include \$68.90 owed to Brad and half of the \$657.10 from bottle collection. The CCC budget at the town meeting was given as \$2700 - presumably \$600 as normally requested and \$2100 for bottle collection. The distinction between the two is important to keep as grants cannot be written without some money being given from the town. Kevin and Glynn will also inquire about separating the bottle account from the other CCC.
- 6) Educational programs with Blake Memorial Library: Butterflies on 7/12 @ 6:30. Linda, Brad and Miranda will go early to help set up; 8/9 Bird habitat/Forest Management.
- 7) Transfer station planting grant: trees and lilies were planted. \$1368 was spent on the \$1100 grant; motion was made (Ken, Lindle) and passed to pay the \$268 back to Ginny Barlow, who covered the overage expense.
- 8) Bottle duty and signage for transfer station: 7/10 Lindle; 7/17 Jon; 7/24 Glynn; 7/31 Brad
- 9) Act 171 outreach program: education and outreach are the main goals; consciousness needs to be raised within the community; ultimately the library will house a collection of educational materials. Ken has a call in to a BioFinder expert and hopes he will come lecture. The CCC will discuss additional possible forums at the next meeting.
- 10) Town Forest parking and trail work: the possibility of putting a gravel parking area in the town forest was discussed, then tabled as members wished to visit the site.
