

## **Corinth Community Coalition Minutes Tuesday, January 11, 2022**

Given that we did not have a quorum, we met informally. Jason Mosel joined our Zoom meeting and described his planned Last Runner Standing race at Northeast Slopes at the end of July 2022.

Participants will race up and down the slopes with each lap dedicated to a marine killed in action during WWII, the Korean, Viet Nam and Afghanistan wars. Jason views this as a community-oriented event. He has formed his own company (Race Mozey) for all of the races he has organized and therefore has contacts with various vendors who donate food and other resources. Jason has already received approval from Wade Pierson at Northeast Slopes for the event. His company carries one million dollar liability insurance. Volunteers would help with setting up markers and posters, clean up after the event, provide water, serve as gofers and lift the spirits of the runners. The Bradford Fast Squad would be enlisted for safety support.

We will put this event on the February meeting agenda to determine if we want to officially support it and make a donation as well.

We also discussed the idea of inviting Cathi Haley, our town Service Officer, to become a member of our leadership team. Jeff reached out to her and she would be “delighted” to become a member of our leadership group.
