- 1) Call to Order @ 7:10

- 5A) Report on new parking lot at Town Forest- looks “wicked good”! Total invoice from Bill Ricker - \$19,755 w/ credit \$2,430 for in-kind work from Town (hauling gravel). Total was \$17,325 compared to estimate of \$18,650. Glynn/Ken recommended reimbursing \$17,325 for parking lot work from grant funding. Unanimous approval. Suggestion of earmarking remainder of grant funds for plowing for winter to test usage of forest. Tabled for further discussion.
- 5B) Town Forest Work Day report: Lookout sign tree has fallen on Orange trail- need drill for sign relocation. Big leaner on Red Trail. Chainsaw needed on Blue Trail. Discussion of more signage for Town Forest- perhaps on paved roads at Cookeville and Brooks Rd.
- 6) Berm at Transfer Station- Marian and Ginny tidied; need to set up a workday. Katharine spoke with Carlotta at WRVS and they are interested in a partnership/ community project in fall. Luke will weed-whack in the meantime.
- 7) Clement Loop Trail- Need to reestablish trail. June 18<sup>th</sup>- 9:30am reconnaissance to determine needs.
- 8) Act 171- House and Senate passed VT 606, was vetoed by governor. Next meeting CCC will review Corinth Forest Block/ Conservation plan to determine local action options.
- 9) Sign for recycling trailer: Travis couldn’t get response from local signmakers. Glynn to reach out to other CCC for partnership- they may have people with time/ talent for creating signage- otherwise we’ll resort to ordering online.
- 10) Bottles: not our month/before next meeting: July 2- Miranda? (Glynn to confirm) July 9<sup>th</sup>- Katharine. Next meeting falls on July 4; reschedule to July 11<sup>th</sup>.
