6. NOTICE TO PERMITTEE:

Driveways cannot interrupt the natural or ditch-line flow of drainage water along the highway. Where required by order of the Selectmen, driveway culverts must be a minimum of 18 inches in diameter and must be forever maintained by the homeowner, developer or landowner.

Driveways must intersect the roadway at a 90-degree angle unless specifically exempted by the Selectmen. Under no circumstances shall a driveway be constructed, graded or altered so as to result in drainage or washing directly out onto the Town Highway.

In the event a driveway causes damage to a Town Highway through improper maintenance, construction or grading, it shall be the responsibility of the property owner to make necessary repairs to the highway upon notification in writing by the Town. The property owner will be held liable for the full expense of such repairs if they must be performed by the Town due to the refusal or inability of the landowner to conduct such repairs.

The permit is issued subject to the directions, restrictions and conditions contained herein and/or in any attachments; and subject to the Town of Corinth Highway Ordinance. This permit covers only the work described or required and then only when such work is performed correctly and as directed. Violations of this permit are subject to the penalties set forth in Title 19, Section 43, V.S.A. (fines of not less than \$100 nor more than \$10,000 for each violation). The issuance of this permit does not release the applicant from any requirements of the statutes, ordinances, rules and/or regulations administered by the State of Vermont or any other governmental agencies.
